## **CREATIVE WORKSHOP: Fantastic Fossils and Spectacular**

**Sculptures** - Be inspired by models, dioramas and fossils in the museum's exhibitions and learn about how museums create replica objects for exhibitions. Experiment with specialist sculpting and mold making materials like silicon and plaster to make your own marvellous models and spectacular sculptures using your favourite objects or specimens.

Create your own molds and casts to fill with a variety of materials like soap, wax, plaster or even chocolate!


