**Mr Richard Simonaitis:** Based in Perth, Richard is the CEO of Grains Australia, bringing extensive industry experience from senior management roles in the grains and export-commodity sectors.

"We are delighted with these appointments at GLNC. It will help steer the future direction of GLNC in the legumes and grains industry, provide important insights on key nutrition and diet trends, and strengthen linkages from farmers to consumers," said Ron Storey.
